#### Exercise 3



#### A stitch in time saves nine

##### Purpose

By the end of this exercise, participants will be able to:

- match interventions with preventative outcomes.

##### Timeframe

30 minutes

##### Resources

- enough copies of **Topic 4, Handout 1** Concerns and preventions table
- two sheets of flipchart paper stuck together with a copy of the table from the handout drawn on them
- flipchart paper and pens

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##### Method

- 1 Divide the participants into pairs, give them the handout and ask them to complete the second column of the table.

Below is an example of how it might be completed.

Handling this concern well...	may prevent
Camp or settlement security	<i>Sexual violence, physical violence</i>
Separated children	<i>Recruitment, sexual violence and exploitation, exploitation of labour, unable to access full rations or attend school, living or working on streets</i>
Child-headed households	<i>Sexual violence and exploitation, exploitation of labour, unable to access full rations or attend school</i>





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Lack of basic food and other essential services	<i>Sexual exploitation, exploitation of labour, living or working on the streets</i>
Camp design, geographic location and social structure	<i>Sexual violence</i>
Availability of fuel and water	<i>Sexual violence, access to education</i>
Inadequate screening of caregivers	<i>Physical violence, sexual exploitation, exploitation of labour, sexual violence</i>
Incarceration in closed detention centres	<i>Physical or sexual violence, unable to attend school</i>
Children and women without their own documentation	<i>Sexual exploitation, exploitation of labour, unable to access full rations or attend school</i>
Lack of child-friendly centres and child participation in service provision	<i>Sexual and labour exploitation, unable to access services or aid</i>
Male responsibility for distribution of aid	<i>Sexual exploitation, unable to access aid</i>

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- 2** In plenary, ask each pair to share their responses and record them on the large copy of the table on flipchart paper, for all to see.
