What change for children? Questions

- 1 What issues are being faced by the most discriminated-against groups?
- 2 What changes (in which areas eg. health, education) are required to reduce discrimination experienced by the most discriminated-against groups?

 - access to relief or services
 - changes in attitudes
 - changes in policies and practices
 - changes in the abilities of discriminated-against groups to claim their rights.
- 3 What evidence will be required to assess whether or not such change has been achieved?
- 4 How will it be measured?
- 5 How will information be collected, how often and by whom?
- 6 How should children receive feedback?
